



Amritanandamayi's empire of secrets

Amritananadamayi's claim to fame is not her oratory or the stories of her miracles—though there are quite a few of those. Her signature act is the embrace that she offers to her devotees, a ritual that earned her the moniker "the hugging saint." Thanks to an impressive public-relations team, extensive political support and a compliant Malayalam media, the popular perception of Amritanandamayi is that of a benevolent figure. But several devotees who interacted closely with her have witnessed a different, often frightening side, describing her as someone money-minded and controlling, prone to fits of rage, and hostile to criticism. For many, her ashram became a gloomy, isolating environment in which they suffered severe mental-health crises and felt trapped. There have been at least two mysterious deaths and several suicides—all of which have gone without adequate investigations, and which the ashram has been dismissive about.




