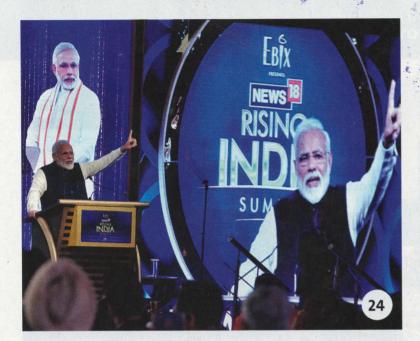

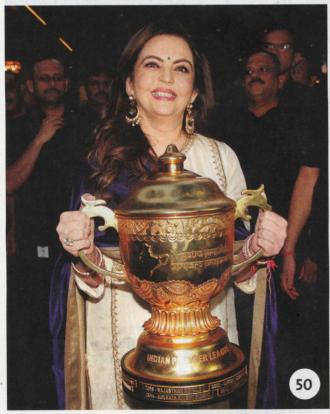
Unreliable News

How Reliance hollowed out Asia's largest media conglomerate

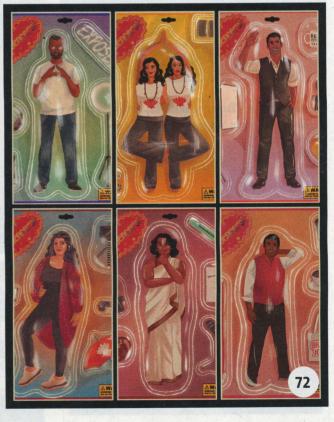

Since Mukesh Ambani took over Network18, the Reliance megaphone has been amplified by the media conglomerate's 21 television news channels in 14 languages—reaching an estimated 400 million viewers—four news websites, three magazines, 18 entertainment channels, 16 international beams and video-ondemand services. Post takeover, many Network18 former and current employees described an organisation whose editorial will had been systematically centralised and set to serve two agendas. Those of Reliance's other businesses and those of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, his government and ideology. The full impact of this new regime lies somewhere between these three vertices: a subtle yet pervasive censorship, the amplification of right-wing narratives and the dismantling of editorial safeguards. The result is a defanged organisation, with its own staff among the greatest casualties of this transformation.



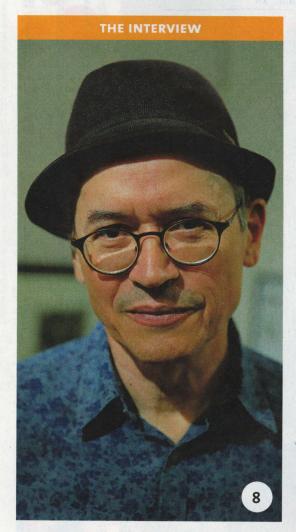

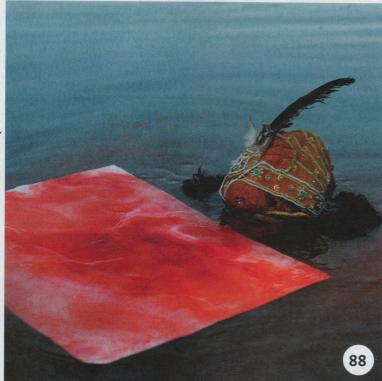
